

## **An Overview**

Don Bosco SYMFEST 2024-25 is a celebration of youth, inspired by the teachings of St. John Bosco, the Father and Founder of the Salesian Congregation.

Born in 1815, Don Bosco dedicated his life to helping young people, especially those at risk.

The Salesian Congregation he established in 1859 now operates in over 137 countries, transforming youth through holistic education rooted in **reason**, **religion**, **and loving-kindness**.

The Salesian Youth Movement - SYM aims to form "faith filled persons and honest citizens" and continues to provide education, guidance, and skills for employment across a wide range of institutions worldwide.

SYM provides a platform for young people to become agents of change in society. SYMFEST 2024-25, to be held at Sacred Heart College, Tirupattur, will bring together 1,500 youth from Salesian provinces across India and South Asia.

With the theme "young people as agents of change: ANCHORED IN HOPE," the event will include sessions on decision-making, media, national aspirations, ecology and cultural exchange.

The gathering highlights the celebration of diversity, encouraging values such as unity, equality, convergence and acceptance.

**SYMFEST focusses on** equipping the youth with the values of justice, peace and harmony. **SYMFEST is the moment of formation of the young as agents of change.** 

Building and strengthening knowledge of the socio-political and economic development of self, others, and the nation.


